Call to Confession (based on Romans 6)

We need to regularly ask ourselves: have we truly died to sin? Do we truly live out of our baptism into Christ? Or do we assume that God will continue to forgive us no matter how we live? So that we do not abuse the Lord's grace, let us admit our failings before God as we pray together:

Prayer of Confession

We confess, O God, that sometimes we fail to see the ways we are hurting and disappointing you. Our shortcomings are silent and hidden from our notice. We refuse to risk caring for others because it's unpopular or inconvenient. We hesitate to speak up on another person's behalf because we are afraid of what it will cost us. Help us see clearly! Grant us grace to bring our living in line with your desires! Hear us as we ask for your mercy in Jesus' name. Amen.

First Scripture Reading: Leviticus 19:9-18

Ann Frost

When you harvest your land's produce, you must not harvest all the way to the edge of your field; and don't gather up every remaining bit of your harvest. Also do not pick your vineyard clean or gather up all the grapes that have fallen there. Leave these items for the poor and the immigrant; I am the Lord your God. You must not steal nor deceive nor lie to each other. You must not swear falsely by my name, desecrating your God's name in doing so; I am the Lord. You must not oppress your neighbors or rob them. Do not withhold a hired laborer's pay overnight. You must not insult a deaf person or put some obstacle in front of a blind person that would cause them to trip. Instead, fear your God; I am the Lord. You must not act unjustly in a legal case. Do not show favoritism to the poor or deference to the great; you must judge your fellow Israelites fairly. Do not go around slandering your people. Do not stand by while your neighbor's blood is shed; I am the Lord. You must not hate your fellow Israelite in your heart. Rebuke your fellow Israelite strongly, so you don't become responsible for his sin. You must not take revenge nor hold a grudge against any of your people; instead, you must love your neighbor as yourself; I am the Lord.

Second Scripture Reading: John 13:31-35

When Judas was gone, Jesus said, "Now the Human One has been glorified, and God has been glorified in him. If God has been glorified in him, God will also glorify the Human One in himself and will glorify him immediately. Little children, I'm with you for a little while longer. You will look for me—but, just as I told the Jewish leaders, I also tell you now—'Where I'm going, you can't come.' "I give you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, so you also must love each other. This is how everyone will know that you are my disciples, when you love each other."
